# Walk through a Sample Lesson

## "Artists Paint Landscapes"

### In one hour and 15 minutes....

Students look at six works of art based on a theme. They will compare and contrast the images.

A Studio Lesson follows the discussion where students create art-based pieces on the theme using a wide variety of media and techniques.


> In the Studio Lessons students don't just replicate the classical art they learn about. Instead, they create their own masterpieces.
